Position Qualifications/Competencies/Gifts:

- Possesses good communication and interpersonal relational skills

Communicating:

- Preach challenging and stimulating sermons which are biblically based on sound doctrine
- Preach on a weekly basis and find guest a or congregational speaker when not available or needing a break.
- Teach and train Elders and volunteer leaders

- Encourage the congregation in ministering to the needs of members and non-members

Administration:
